KEEP UP THE GOOD WORK!

So far, so... **GREAT!** Partners in Giving Campaign Chairs and Volunteers Coordinators are doing something *very right* to date! That's because the latest totals from Partners in Giving show donations to the 2017 Campaign are *slightly ahead* of donations at the same time last year. Now that is great news! **Last year, the Partners in Giving campaign raised \$2.5 million for 520 charities.**

TOTAL NUMBER OF DONORS UP SLIGHTLY, TOO

The first report capturing the initial two weeks of the campaign show that at that early stage, the campaign is ahead of last year with close to **\$464,000 so far!** Partners in Giving 2017 is also ahead in the early report in number of donors. The report shows a total of **1,645** direct donors compared to 1,624 at the same time last year! **CONGRATULATIONS!** Both UW and UW Health are a slightly ahead in donors, while the number for state agencies is lagging a wee bit behind, but will soon catch up!
