New 2019 Campaign pledge form

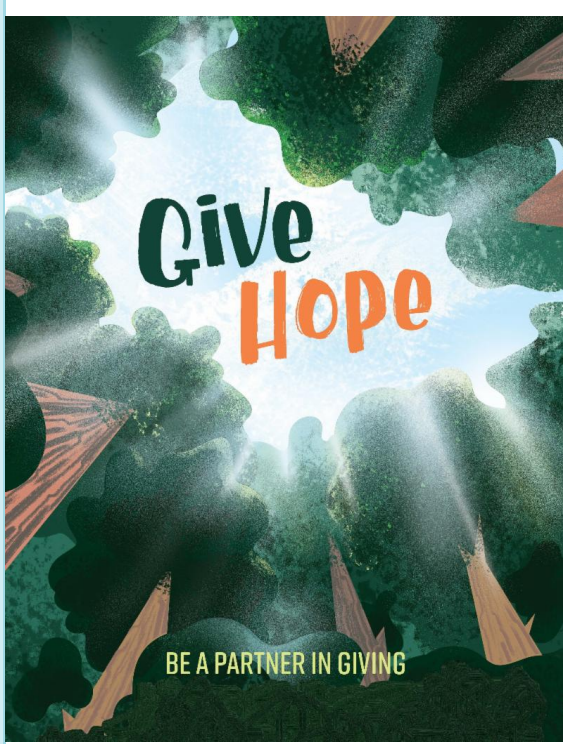
- Partners in Giving donors will see a **brand new paper pledge form** this fall.
- To reduce printing costs, the Campaign has gone from using a 3-ply form to a **single-sheet pledge form**.
- **The move is saving thousands of dollars and** creating efficiencies in pledge form processing!
- The **back side** of the paper form tells prospective donors who we are and what we do.

Campaign materials

- **State materials** have been delivered to **all state agencies**.
- **University materials** will be on site and **ready for pick up by Monday, Oct. 7.**
